

## RENO-TAHOE THREE-DAY TOUR ITINERARY

Experience the Reno-Tahoe Territory, a vast and diverse region of high desert valleys, majestic tree-lined mountains and world famous Lake Tahoe. There's no other place that can claim the beauty of Lake Tahoe, the action and adventure of the "Biggest Little City in the World," the rich history of the Comstock Lode, and the state's oldest recorded settlement – all within a 60- minute drive of each other.

### DAY ONE

Begin in Reno with a tour of the [National Automobile Museum](#) which features a collection of more than 220 vintage and classic cars, including the 1907 Thomas Flyer, winner of the 1908 New York to Paris race.



Then off to historic [Virginia City](#), just 40 minutes away. Be prepared to “step back in time.” Discover shops, museums and antique treasures in this historic mining town. Take a ride on the Virginia City Trolley, which packs more than 100 years of history into a 20-minute narrated ride. Explore the [Historic Fourth Ward School](#), the last of its kind still standing in the USA, and catch the [Virginia & Truckee Railroad](#) for a narrated round-trip to nearby Gold Hill.



Return to Reno or continue on to Nevada's state capital, Carson City, only 30 minutes away.

### DAY TWO

In [Carson City](#), tour the [Nevada State Capitol](#), constructed in 1870, making it the oldest capitol building west of the Mississippi. Walk over to the [Nevada State Museum](#), a portion of which served as the Carson City Mint where coins were minted from 1870 to 1893. Groups can also enjoy the Nevada State Railroad Museum, 1.5 miles south on US Hwy 395 S.



Continue on to the nearby towns of Minden and Gardnerville to explore

antique shops, Basque restaurants and more.



Next, it's the [Town of Genoa](#), Nevada's oldest permanent settlement. See [Mormon Station State Park](#) and the [Genoa Courthouse Museum](#), built in 1865 and rebuilt in 1910.

Travel via SR207/Kingsbury Grade to spectacular [Lake Tahoe](#), the largest alpine lake in North America. Spend the evening exploring the shops, galleries and restaurants in the [Heavenly Village](#), or take a seat at your favorite slot machine.

### DAY THREE

Visit [Zephyr Cove Resort](#), home of the [M.S. Dixie II Paddlewheeler](#). Enjoy a two-hour sightseeing cruise to Emerald Bay, one of the most photographed places in the world, and enjoy the views of Lake Tahoe.



Return to Reno via US Hwy 50 E and I-580 or continue on to Sacramento and San Francisco via US Hwy 50 W and I-80 W.
