Nevada State Museum

Just north of the capital building; 600 North Carson St.

In addition to the **Railroad Museum**, **Battle Born Hall**, **Children's Museum** and the **Fire Museum**, another must-see is the **Nevada State Museum**. It engages diverse audiences in understanding and celebrating Nevada's natural and cultural heritage. The museum presents heritage through unique and authentic educational experiences, enhanced by an environment of comfort, interaction, and inspiration. Walk through the former Carson City Mint building, learn from the Native Americans who first occupied the Nevada portion of the Great Basin, and take a tour of the famous underground mine exhibit. Be sure to see the USS Nevada Battleship.
